A Lighthouse Point Library card is required for enrollment and registration.

The Lighthouse Point Library is a City (rather than county) library. We are funded by the City of Lighthouse Point, grants, and donations. Lighthouse Point Library cards are free of charge for all Lighthouse Point residents, business owners, and their children. Adults and youth (under the age of 4 and over the age of 13) who do not reside in the City of Lighthouse Point are welcome to join the library for the low annual fee of \$50.00 per family (at the same full address). Students, who are 4 to 13 years of age, and teachers MAY be eligible for a student/educator card.

ENROLLMENT IN ADULT PROGRAMS: Before attending your first class session you will need to enroll in the 2016/2017 Senior Class Programs with your Lighthouse Point Library Card and driver's license. If your driver's license does not have your Lighthouse Point address on it, you will also need to bring a utility bill, property tax bill, or lease with your name and Lighthouse Point address on it.

**REGISTRATION ADULTS INDIVIDUAL CLASS:** To stay under the Fire Marshal capacity for each room, several classes require individual registration. Registration is available online at lighthousepointlibrary.com. Your pin number is the <a href="first SIX numbers">first SIX numbers</a> of your Lighthouse Point Library card.

**REGISTRATION KIDS DAYTIME STORY TIME:** To stay under the Fire Marshal capacity for the story time room, registration is required for daytime story times. Registration is available online at lighthousepointlibrary.com. Your pin number is the **first SIX numbers** of your Lighthouse Point Library card. Night time story time does not require registration.

If you are a Lighthouse Point resident with small children visiting, please call us about a short term story time pass.

Reminder...Before attending any adult program ALL participants must fill out a new 2016/17 enrollment form with their LHP Library Card. You will need a current Lighthouse Point Library Card and IDs to enroll in any senior programs. Lighthouse Point Library cards are free for all Lighthouse Point residents and \$50 (annually) for non-City residents. Please note, any course/event may be cancelled, filled, or rescheduled at any time. A library card does not guarantee enrollment in or offering of courses. Most courses run September through May with breaks for holidays or special events. The Library is able to offer adult classes thanks to a group of wonderful volunteer instructors, annual grant funding, and the support of the Friends of the Library and the City of Lighthouse Point.
