

Supplies:


- Groundhog

Using the supplies provided you will be creating a groundhog shadow puppet.


1. Color your groundhog.

3. **You're done!**

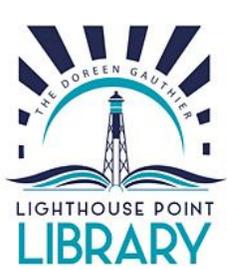

Project!

This project is to make a valentine by using shadows.



Instructions!

Supplies:

- 1 empty paper towel tube
- 4 pieces of cellophane
- 4 rubber bands
- (Not provided by the library) - scissors
- (Not provided by the library) - black marker or sharpie
- (Not provided by the library) - a flashlight

The supplies for this project, unless otherwise noted, are supplied by the library.

1. Use a black marker or sharpie to write a message on the pieces of cellophane. Each piece should have 1 letter or symbol, and it should be smaller than the circle of the paper towel tube.
2. Cut your paper towel tube into 4 pieces.
3. For each piece of paper towel tube, take a piece of cellophane and place it on top, drawing side down and centered in the middle of the paper tube hole.
4. Take a rubber band and fasten the cellophane to the paper tube.
5. (Optional: Tape the tubes together in a line that forms the message.)
6. In a dark room, shine a flashlight toward a blank part of a wall or floor, and scan your message slowly in front of the light, projecting it out as a shadow!
