In-person teen volunteering is open to ages 13 to 17.

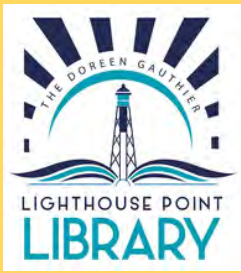

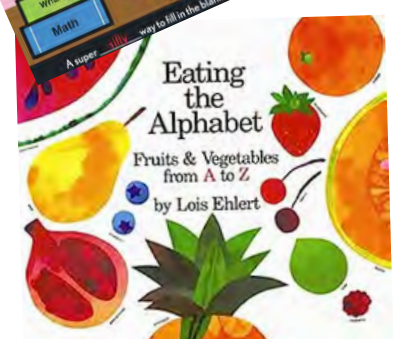
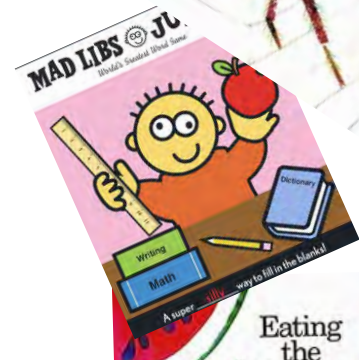
