

Materials:

- 1 Toilet Paper Tube
- 1 Piece of Construction Paper
- Craft Glue
- 2 Large Pompoms (or cotton balls)
- 2 Small Pompoms (or cotton balls trimmed until much smaller)
- Two Googly Eyes
- Several Pieces of Colorful Tissue Paper
- Scissors
- Pencil



Directions:

First, glue some parts.

- Glue one googly eye to each large pompom. Set aside to dry.
- Cut a strip of construction paper that can be wrapped around the toilet paper tube. Glue the strip to the toilet paper tube. Set aside to dry.

Next, make (fake) fire!

- Cut long triangular strips from the tissue paper. You will need about ten strips. You can use colors that look like fire or any colors that you like.
- Glue the tissue paper strips to the inside of the toilet paper tube. You might need to add more glue and create several layers of tissue paper strips.

Finally, put it all together!

- Glue the large pompoms (with the googly eyes attached) near the top of the tube.
- The top of the tube is the edge that does not have tissue paper strips glued to it.
- Glue the two smaller pompoms close to the bottom of the tube.
- The bottom is the edge that has the tissue paper strips glued to it. These are the dragon's nostrils.
- Once the glue dries, blow into the top of the tube and see the dragon "blowing fire."

Storyologist Idea

This dragon design was inspired by Page Turner's DRAMA DRAGON STORY. Can you make up your own story about a dragon? What is your dragon's name? Can it fly? Does it blow fire? What if instead it blew bubbles?
