

Materials:

- 1 Gallon Ziploc Bag (quart size will also work)
- 1 Piece of Black (or dark blue)
- Construction Paper
- 1 Piece of Construction Paper, Any Color, for the Flashlight Handle (approximately 4"X2")
- 1 Piece of White Paper (or white card stock)
- Scissors
- Permanent Markers
- Scotch Tape or Glue
- 1 Copy of the Attached Safari Scene Template (optional)



Directions:

First make the safari scene:

- Place the Safari Scene Template in the plastic bag. You might need to cut the sides of the bag to make it fit.
- Using a permanent marker trace the safari scene onto the plastic bag OR trace another scene Or draw your own scene using your imagination.
- Color in your scene with permanent markers.
- Remove the template.
- Insert the dark piece of construction paper into your bag. You may need to cut the bag or the paper to make it fit. Your scene will look very dark. In fact, it might be hard to see at all.
- That's okay! It's supposed to look like that.

Next make the flashlight:

- Draw a cone shape on the white paper. It should be about 4" on top and 2" on the bottom.
- Cut out the cone and set it aside. This will be the "light that shines" from your flashlight.
- Cut out a 2" wide rectangle from the colored construction paper. Draw some buttons on it. This is your flashlight.
- Tape the cone to the flashlight. This should now look like a flashlight that has light shining from it.

Finally, put it together and let the light shine!

- Insert the flashlight into the bag between the plastic and the dark paper.
- Move your flashlight around to "light up" your scene and go on your safari!
