## TEEN PROGRAMS

### Teen Virtual Volunteering

January 19 to May 08

Teens receive three volunteer hours for reading and video reviewing kids' books from the Lighthouse Point Library's collection. Videos are posted to the library's website. Teens can earn up to nine volunteer hours (for three book reviews) a quarter and guidelines are sent to registered participants. Tracking school volunteer requirements are each teen's responsibility. Adjudicated hours are not eligible. Teen must have a Lighthouse Point Library card to participate.



### Teen Volunteering Color A Smile

Audience: Ages 13 to 17

Color A Smile is a nonprofit organization that distributes cheerful drawings to nursing homes, hospitals, meals on wheels programs, our troops overseas, and anyone in need of a smile.

Teens can earn up to three volunteer hours a quarter and guidelines are sent to registered participants. Tracking school volunteer requirements are each teen's responsibility. Adjudicated hours are not eligible. Teen must have a Lighthouse Point Library card to participate.
